DIVISIONS AND ELIGIBILITY



Divisions	Birth Years
U9	2015 / 2016
U11	2013 / 2014
U13	2011 / 2012
U15	2009 / 2010

- **Teams should indicate their level at the time of registration – A or AA level.**
- **AA – higher level**
- **If there are 3-4 teams in each level, the organizers may split into 2 levels for that division.**
- **Date of birth will be strictly enforced (NO EXCEPTIONS)**
- **No overaged players allowed.**
- **Teams may request for younger players to play in a higher age division. Approval required.**
- **Maximum number of players per team – 15 players and 2 goalies.**

GAME FORMAT AND NOTES



- 5 on 5 (5 players and a goalie)
- Game time – 3 periods of 13 minutes running time.
- Stop time in the final 2 mins if the score is within 2 goals
- Each team is permitted one time-out (30 secs)
- In the round robin, if the game is tied, the teams will play a 3 min overtime session – 3 on 3
- In the playoffs, if the game is tied, the teams will play a 5 min overtime session – 3 on 3. Except in the Championship game where a second overtime period will be played.
- If still tied, a shootout will determine the winner
- Team standings based on – Most points, most wins, head to head, least goals against, higher goals for, least penalty minutes, greater goal difference and puck toss.
- Teams should have both a dark and a light set of jerseys and socks.
- Additional rules will be announced prior to the start of the tournament.
- Awards presentation will be presented after each Final.
- A party for the players at the Rink will be held at the conclusion of the tournament.
- Final confirmation of the Rules and Format will be released prior to the start of the tournament.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. Which venue will our team play at?**
 - a. All games will be at the Thailand International Ice Arena. However, if we do get an overflow of teams, do note that some of the U9 and U11 games will be played at the Warrior Ice Arena.
- 2. Can we save a spot in the tournament?**
 - a. Teams are only confirmed once payment and rosters are submitted.
- 3. When is my team expected to arrive in Bangkok?**
 - a. All teams should arrive no later than Tuesday, July 9. Teams are expected to start play by July 10. Please bear in mind of quarantine measures if required.
- 4. When can we book our return tickets?**
 - a. Teams can plan their departure on Sunday, July 14 or after.
- 5. What about hotels and transportation?**
 - a. We do have contacts for hotel and bus companies and for those teams that require assistance with bookings, you may contact Mr. Peter Chung - peter@majesticoutsourcing.com.
- 6. Are we allowed to have an exception on players that is barely over the age requirement?**
 - a. NO exceptions – do not try to bring any over aged players into the division that your team has signed up for. We have a strict policy by checking every game. Any teams found with an over aged player will be disqualified from this and future tournaments. Please do not create an unhappy situation for the player, their family and the team.

7. **What if we do not have a goalie?**
 - a. We can try to assist in finding a goalie however, we suggest to put a player from the team as the designated goalie.
8. **Is there a Pro Shop at the Rink?**
 - a. Yes – at the Thailand Ice Hockey Arena. Skate Sharpening is also available.
9. **Is there storage or dressing rooms at the Rink?**
 - a. There will be 4 designated dressing rooms at each venue – Teams will be allowed to use them during their scheduled games however, they will need to remove their gear within 25 mins after completion of their game to allow the teams in the following games to use.
10. **What if we only have one set of jerseys?**
 - a. We highly recommend that teams prepare BOTH a dark and white set of jerseys with matching socks. If there is a colour clash situation where both teams only have one set, the team designated as the visitor will be required to change with a generic set. Matching jerseys and socks required.
11. **How long will it take to travel from one venue to another,?**
 - a. Assuming the traffic is light, it should not take more than 20 mins.

SPECIAL NOTE



In the event that Covid-19 again causes restrictions for travelers coming in to Thailand or if any reasons that the tournament needs to be cancelled, all team fees will be refunded. However, the organizers will not be able to refund airplane tickets, hotels or any other travelling expenses.

We ask that all players and parents to follow Thailand's entry requirements at the time of the start of the Tropical Freeze tournament. For instance, if they require to show vaccine certificates, this will also be required when checking in at tournament. We want to ensure that all participants in the tournament and entering the ice rink comply with all the requirements, so everyone has a peace of mind that they are in a safe environment.
